

## Goret Road to El Camino del Cerro

Thank you for your interest in the Silverbell Road project.

The Silverbell Road Project utility relocation is underway. In advance of the roadway construction, the utility companies are required to relocate their facilities out of the way of the future roadway. During this work the traveling public can expect the following:

## **Ongoing Utility Work:**

Multiple utility and communication companies (Tucson Electric Power, Lumen, Southwest Gas, Tucson Water and more) are working along Silverbell Road. Crews are relocating their services to accommodate the widening of Silverbell Road, between Goret Road and El Camino del Cerro.

- On Wednesday, June 8, from 7 a.m. 3 p.m., Tucson Electric Power will be working at Silverbell Road and Goret Road. Workers will be flagging traffic as needed. <u>Motorists should anticipate being temporarily</u> stopped at times during the work.
- On Thursday, June 9, from 7 a.m. 3 p.m., Tucson Electric Power will be working at the intersection of Silverbell Road and Sweetwater Drive. <u>Police officers will be directing traffic.</u>
- During the week of June 13, Tucson Electric Power will be pulling wires and adjusting poles. Large trucks, construction vehicles, and workers may be entering and exiting the roadway and motorists will be shifted from side to side during this work.
- Motorists should be aware of construction activity and drive with caution.
- Be aware that workers could be flagging traffic as needed and motorists could be temporarily stopped at times.
- As a reminder, the speed limit throughout the work zone is 25 mph.
