Silverbell Road

is a critical regional transportation link that serves the west and northwest portions of the Tucson metropolitan area. This major transportation improvement project was approved by voters in May 2006 as part of the Regional Transportation Authority Plan. The voter-approved Plan calls for Silverbell Road to be improved to a 4-lane divided desert parkway to include pedestrian facilities, bike lanes, drainage improvements and new native landscaping. This roadway improvement project will promote mobility and provide improved capacity and safety.

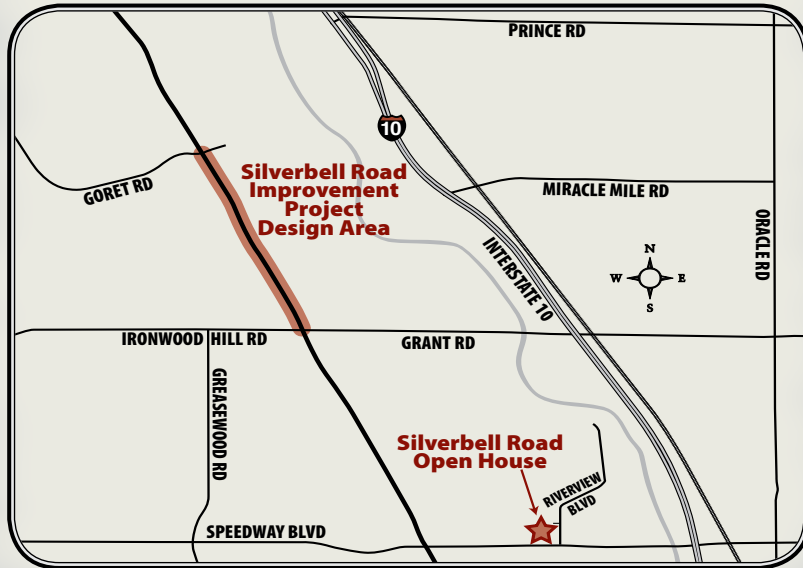

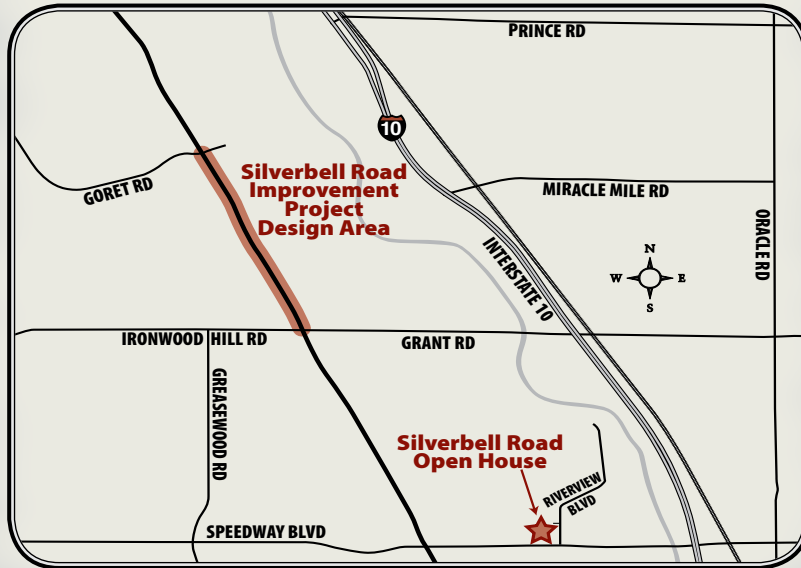
