



Thank you for your interest in the Silverbell Road project.

The Silverbell Road Project is **expected to be complete by the end of next week.** In advance of the completion, the contractor will be onsite finishing landscaping, access ramps, and utility adjustments in the area. The traveling public can expect the following:

On Monday, December 5, and Tuesday, December 6, from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. each day the following traffic control will be in place:

- Intermittent lane closures along north and southbound Silverbell Road while the contractor completes landscaping work in the area
- One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction
- Once work is complete in an area, the traffic control will be removed

Beginning 7 a.m., Wednesday, December 7, through 7 a.m., Thursday, December 8, the contractor will complete manhole adjustments along the curb lane of north and southbound Silverbell Road, from Grant Road to just north of Goret Road.

- North and southbound travel will be shifted around the work areas
- Restrictions will remain in place for 24 hours in order to allow the concrete to cure
- Turn movements will not be impacted by this work
- Side street access and business access will be maintained

As a reminder, the speed limit throughout the work zone is 25 MPH. This will not change until the project is complete for the safety of the workers and the traveling public.
